Pedagogic Themes

In our little yellow villa we accompany children aged from 1 to 3 years. Children of many different nationalities from predominantly studying, but also working parents, are cared for by us.



Our pedagogical concept

We work according to the situational approach and elements of Reggio pedagogy. Both approaches are based on the child, their interests, abilities and needs. We see ourselves as partners of the child, supporting him in his autonomous, individual observation and understanding of the world. In doing so, we take into account the children's different learning pace and allow them time and space for their development. Empathy and appreciation for the children and parents are the basis for a good cooperation. We record the children's learning and developmental steps in "portfolio folders". We observe and photograph the children during their activities and document their learning and activities through pictorial learning stories.



The settling in process

The acclimation of the children is based on a trusting relationship between the specialist and the child and the specialist and the parents. Together with the parents we gently accustom the child to the new environment. Each child is accompanied by a reference educator, who offers him/her a secure relationship and provides security. Only when the children feel comfortable with us can they develop freely and make many experiences.
